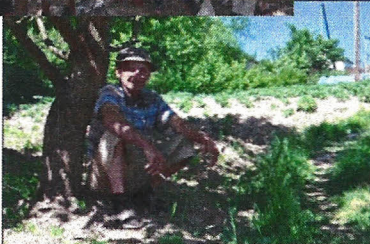


Please Support Hannah Katz's JDC

Trip to Ukraine

At Chesed Aryeh in Lvov, our group painted the backyard playground and did repair work for clients of the chesed center. We scraped lead paint and black mold off of the walls of homes, did landscaping work, and other household repairs.



At Beitenu in Kiev, our group ran a camp for young children. Beitenu runs programs for both young children and the elderly and acts as a social support organization.

In Kiev, we worked to beautify a playground at a Jewish kindergarten. We cleaned up glass and used syringes and chopped down dead trees to make the area safer for the children. We also installed slides and swing sets.
